


Please read this document before installing the fonts in BuenosAires_AlternativGlyphs_V2.zip

Step 1: Locate the font folder.

From here, you can view any font installed on your system, as well as add new ones or remove those you don't need anymore. When removing fonts, I'd recommend extreme caution, as many are considered System Fonts, meaning Windows uses them within certain programs.

Open the Windows Control Panel.



Select Appearance and Personalization.



NB! If you have previously installed Easees font (named *BuenosAires_Alternativ*), you need to remove this before installing the new version.

To delete the font family called “*BuenosAires_Alternativ*”, right click the chosen font and select Delete.



Click Yes when prompted.

Now restart your PC.



Step 2: To install the font, unzip the folder simply drag the font files found in “BuenosAires_AlternativGlyphs_V2 > Desktop” into the font window.
